

Downtown Directory Is Complete; Available At Chamber Offices

There's something new in Milford. It's the Downtown Directory — complete and available for sale at the Chamber of Commerce building, 5 Broad Street.

The creation of Patti Calistro, owner of Studio 3, 15 River St., the directory,

“dedicated to the future of downtown,” includes a map of downtown, list of merchants, a history of Milford, map of the Harbor, and transportation information.

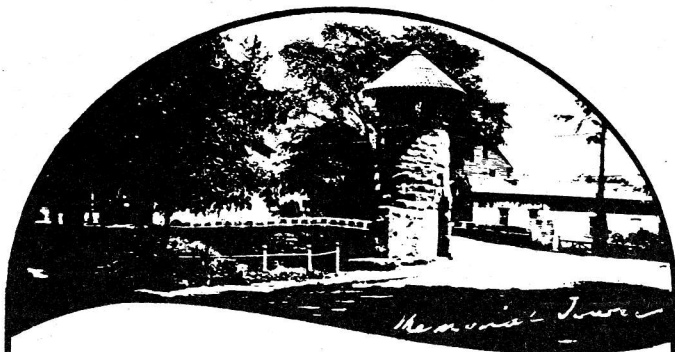
The booklet, which costs \$1.50, is a collection of information never before brought

together within the confines of a cover. Attractively laid out, black and white photographs and drawings enhance the 22-page booklet done in stylized calligraphy.

The idea for the directory was developed during Calistro's tenure as chairman of the Downtown Council. She recently resigned that post of the now defunct council to concentrate on activities that are fulfilling to her personal style. “I've been frustrated with the lack of co-operation within the city. There are so many who stifle progress.”

Calistro has focused her energies on refurbishing her store front, developing programs for the Kids' Studio and working with a youth group that “didn't have anything to do.” The youth group has been working on an outdoors mural behind Center Auto Body, downtown.

The artist has stressed that her desire to turn downtown into a “happening” that would bring tourists and shoppers into the area is something to benefit the whole community. “I've had some people tell me, I'm doing it for my own glory.” As her statement to those who may doubt her, Calistro has respectfully given credit to her ideas where credit is due. On the back cover of the directory it states: “...for the Glory of God.”
